



## **IHE accelerator Coordination Task Force**

As of June 22, 2025

IHE-Europe may host, or engage in, IHE accelerators to address specific market-driven or regulatory priorities with European scope, as defined in the IHE International governance.

To drive and coordinate the engagement of IHE-Europe representatives in a specific IHE accelerator, IHE-Europe sets up a task force under the EU Affairs Committee.

The Task Force will be named

or short ""<name of the IHE accelerator> TF"

An IHE accelerator Coordination Task Force is responsible for the following activities:

- A. Adherence of the IHE accelerator to the evolving IHE International Governance for IHE accelerators.
- B. Ensuring alignment of the IHE accelerator with the IHE Domain Coordination Committee and the relevant IHE Domains.
- C. Reporting to the Domain Coordination Committee and the IHE Europe Steering Committee.
- D. Establishment of engagement of (European) IHE representatives in the IHE accelerator.
- E. For IHE accelerator frameworks which are established in collaboration with other organizations: alignment with the corresponding Joint Technical Committee see Attachment vii.b to the IHE-Europe Internal Rules)
- F. Planning of IHE accelerator related activities for events along the specification creation and testing continuum such as Plugathons, IHE Connectathons etc.
- G. In case specifications are created by the IHE accelerator and not through IHE Domain Committees: ensuring the specification of test cases and the development of test tools.
- H. For specifications which have been created by the IHE accelerator and are agreed with the Domain Coordination Committee to be of global value: drive the internationalization of the specifications by the relevant IHE Domain Committees and, as necessary, the creation of European level specializations of these international IHE Profiles, incl. potential publication of the European level specializations in Volume 4 of the relevant IHE Technical Frameworks.
